




St. Sharbel's Christmas Schedule

- **Feast of the Immaculate Conception** (vigil), December 7th at 7:00pm. This is a holy day of obligation and may be met by attending Mass with us on Weds night or at any Roman Rite church on Thursday the 8th.
- **Christmas Novena** — begins December 15th thru (and including) December 23rd each day at 10:30 am (on Sundays it occur with Mass). Families who cannot make it are urged to pray the Novena as a family each day. Please note this is not a Eucharistic liturgy, but one of Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament.
- **Breakfast with Papa Noel, December 18:** Maronteens and Crossroads Youth will be serving up a delicious breakfast after Mass, and Papa Noel will be attending! Proceeds from the breakfast will go to the Monks of Jesus Mary and Joseph.
- **Christmas Eve Mass**, December 24th: 5:30 PM, Christmas pageant/ children's choir to preform with Mass following around 6:00 PM.
- **Christmas Day Mass**, December 25th: 9:00AM Christmas Mass. [Note: There is NO 10:30AM Mass on Christmas Day.] Parishioners are encouraged to attend the vigil Mass on Christmas Eve or the Mass on Christmas morning, both are not required.
New Years Day, January 1st, 2015: Mass at 10:30AM, as per normal.

Abouna's Corner

THE BIRTH OF JOHN THE BAPTIST

Luke 1: 57-66

On this Sunday, the Church and her children, join with Zechariah and Elizabeth to celebrate the birth of the St. John the Baptist with songs of joy, praise and thanksgiving. The Gospel of Saint Luke the evangelist, celebrates the fulfillment of God's promises made long ago, his kindness, and his compassion. While it is a personal song of joy for the birth of a child, it now has become a universal song of salvation on behalf of all humanity.

In Semitic religious traditions names have meaning and purpose; the name "John" (*Youhanan in Hebrew*) means: "God is kind and gracious." Thus, the child John, will grow to become an expression of that graciousness poured out in the form of forgiveness of sins by the river Jordan – the first baptismal fountain! Like John we too are called to become forerunners for Christ in our world by ourselves becoming expressions of God's forgiveness and grace.

The Church, joins on this *Jubilee of the Birth of the Forerunner of the Lord*, "the infant of grace" – who makes straight his paths – revealing the graciousness of God for his people. In the Hoosoyo she recollects this astonishing birth with praise and thanksgiving that extend throughout infinity. She draws her children to listen attentively to the announcement of the Baptizer made at his birth, and later by him by the river Jordan.

From the birth of John we look mystically forward to the birth of the Beloved Son of God: "like people awaiting a new dawn and like a ship whose watchman has seen the land"! We behold this as the sign and expression of God's fatherly loving-care towards us and all of his creation. It is so fitting, therefore, to follow this remembrance of the graciousness of God liturgically with the tree-time holy praises of the Trinity: "Qadeeshat Aloho"!

Let us move on to show our thanksgiving by praying together the living Creed: the gift of faith, the remembrance of love, and the expression of Christian joy. Like this holy child of joy, John, whose name is only a reminder of God's infinite mercy, now we offer our faith, handed down from one generation to another, as the hope for the ages!


