


# **Abouna's Corner**

#### THE GLORIOUS BIRTH OF OUR LORD

Our Western culture has paired Christmas down into gift-giving and family time. Of course, all of this is good, but as believers we have an even better reason to look forward to Christmas: we are celebrating the coming of Emmanuel, "God with us," the One who "will save his people from their sins" (Matthew 1:23, 21).

Yes, Jesus is God with us. And yes, he came to save us from sin. These are two of the most inspiring, encouraging truths we could ever learn about our Catholic faith. They tell us how much God loves us, and they tell us how much he wants to work in our lives.

On the one hand, God has always been with us. He created us out of love, and when you love someone, you don't abandon them. He stayed with us even after we had fallen, after Adam has removed his Robe of Glory.

The Hebrew Bible is one long story of God's faithfulness to his people. We see it in stories of Abraham, Moses, and David. We see it in the Israelites' wanderings in the desert and in their long history of ups and downs in the Promised Land. God never left them.

But then, after nearly two thousand years of staying close to his people, God did something far more powerful than he had ever done before. He didn't just stay "with us" in a spiritual sense; he actually became one of us and lived among us as a man like us in all things but sin. There's a passage in the Bible that beautifully emphasizes this distinction between God's work before and after Jesus came among us:

In times past, God spoke in partial and various ways to our ancestors through the prophets; in these last days, he spoke to us through a son, whom he made heir of all things and through whom he created the universe. John's Gospel emphasizes the graciousness of God and the glory of God. John tells us, "The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us, and we saw his glory, the glory as of the Father's only Son, full of grace and truth" (John 1:14).

When Jesus came to be with us, he came to *speak God's word* in a new way. He came to *reveal God's love* in a new way, and he came to *sacrifice himself for us* in a new way. Let us rejoice and give thanks for Christ's birth amongst us!
