

ABOUNA'S CORNER

SUNDAY OF THE PRIESTS (Sharing in the High Priesthood of Christ)

1 Timothy 4: 6 - 16 / Luke 12: 42 - 48

On this Sunday, we the Church and her children, celebrate the memory of all the departed bishops and their assistants the priests, who have shared in the service of the priesthood of Christ and served their people well. They are called *Good Shepherds*, like Jesus himself, and who cared deeply for their flock. Now in her prayers, the Church, remembers them during this season of light, Epiphany, and prays for them with gratitude.

The Letter to the Hebrews reveals *Christ as the High Priest* who opens the Sanctuary of God, once and for all, for all humanity to enter. He has become *the bridge* who links God's heart with our hearts, so that through him, mercy and grace may flow freely between humanity and divinity. This is what our priests do every Sunday: they invoke and open this channel of divine grace – through Christ who opens for us and shares with us his divine priesthood.

The priesthood of Christ is exemplified in our bishops, the descendants of the Apostles of Christ, and in the ordained priests of our communities. As we look forward to a visit from our bishop or to new and upcoming ordinations which will occur in the Eparchy this year (including the Ordination of Brother John Michael) we are reminded by the Scriptures of this special gift of priesthood as a manifestation of Jesus Christ's presence among us. This gift of priesthood is one of the many gifts that we share as we bear Christ's light in us and among us: Emanuel (God is with us!)

Our Scripture readings today show us how this gift, of the laying of hands over the head of the one ordained, is a special gift sanctified by the Apostolic Church: so that the graces of God's sacraments may flow freely through the ordained. The priest becomes the *Steward of Christ* who gives his people their *bread from heaven* in due time for sustenance through his divine power.

And now as we pray in thanksgiving for this wonderful gift of the priesthood, and the service of the shepherds – bishops and priests of the past – let us also pray for the priests and shepherds of the future, that this service may not be rationed through shortages in vocations. Let us do whatever we can to encourage our priests and those in ministry for greater dedication, as our service to Christ himself: the Lamb of God's love and the High Priest of all bishops and priests.
