

#### **LENTEN/HOLY WEEK 2017 REMINDERS**

**People focus on fasting and it's important.** As a reminder, the Most Reverend Bishops Elias Zaidan and Gregory Mansour have previously issued the following Lenten guidelines for the Maronites of the U.S.:

- All Maronites over the age of 14, who are physically capable, are to **abstain** from meat on Ash Monday and all Fridays of Lent.
- Ash Monday and the Great Friday of the Crucifixion are also days of **fasting**. Fasting in the Maronite Church involves eating and drinking nothing at all (except water and medicine) from midnight until noon. The rest of the day normal meals can be taken, but without meat. All Maronites who are physically capable are to fast on these two days.

To say it another way:

- Ash Monday fast until noon, then no meat
- All Fridays during Lent abstain from meat, no fasting required
- Good Friday fast until noon, then no meat

Abstinence means no eating of meat. Fasting means no food or beverage (except for water) between 12 Midnight to 12 Noon. Those over 60, and those with any medical condition or illness where fasting is deleterious are dispensed from this obligation, as are those who are required to preform strenuous labor. (As a reminder, each Sunday during lent is a celebration of the Resurrection and isn't therefore Lent, so any things you have give up for Lent are properly set aside on Sundays).

**But there is more than fasting!** Great Lent is a time of prayer, penance, and change of heart; turning from sin and facing the Lord. Fasting and abstinence are part of the larger program we are encouraged to engage in during Lent. All parishioners are encouraged to seek Sacrament of Reconciliation at some point before Easter Sunday. You are encouraged to give to those less fortunate, either through the second collection for Bishop's charity or to individuals or organizations.

### **ABOUNA'S CORNER**

#### CLEANSING OF THE LEPER <u>Mk 1:35-45</u>

On this Sunday, in our Maronite prayers, Our Lord is referred to as the Physician of our souls and bodies. The symbolic connection between leprosy and sin cannot be overlooked in our gospel readings for this Sunday's Lenten Gospel. In the first reading St. Paul speaks of the grace of Christ that makes us righteous before God though we are sinners. In a parallel way, in the Gospel of Mark, Jesus heals the leper because of his great compassion towards him and makes him whole.

It seems to me that these parallel readings, of Jesus the Lord as our healer, in the Church's teaching during Lent is quite intentional. Combined with the Sunday of the Prodigal Son; the healings that we hear about in the Gospels of Lent remind us of something essential: that we need to be healed, and that we need to let Christ the Lord be the healer.

In our Syriac tradition this healing power of Christ is presented to us by his bride, the Church, and our mother, through her holy mysteries (in Syriac "raze", in English - sacraments). Saint Ephrem, called the Harp of the Holy Spirit, and named as Doctor of the Universal Chuch, speaks of this:

With three medicines You have cured our sickness; Humanity was weak, suffering and failing; You have strengthened it by your blessed bread, You have consoled it with your sober wine, And You have given it joy with your holy anointing.

Now is the season to seek out these healing-sacraments (Raze) of Christ. It is the time that we use the confessional as a means of acknowledging our sinfulness, and the Eucharist as the channel through which the graces of Christ – of healing and forgiveness – with the overflowing power of his Holy Spirit are poured out into us.

During this Lenten Season, let us all see the places in our which are broken, those places that need healing. God will come in, but he needs us to ask him, to invite him.


