Funds raised will go towards local Catholic Charities agencies' efforts to assist families and individuals with shelter, food, and other immediate and long-term recovery needs.

# House Bill 3391 Forces Abortion Coverage and Expands Taxpayer-Funded Abortion

The day after our country celebrated Independence Day, the Oregon State Legislature passed a bill that has more to do with force than it does with freedom. House Bill 3391, which has now been signed into law by Governor Brown, forces insurance companies to cover abortion agenda that does not enjoy majority support.

By insisting on complete insurance coverage of abortion, including late-term and sex-selective abortions, the legislature and the Governor show intolerance of widely held opposing views and will compel thousands of Oregonians to support what their conscience rejects.

Oregonians opposed to House Bill 3391 should lend their support to the Stop Taxpayer Funding for Abortion Act. This measure needs 117,000 signatures to qualify as an initiative for the 2018 election.

#### REFELECTION

#### FOURTEENTH SUNDAY OF PENTECOST SEASON

Heeding the Word (Martha & Mary)

LK 10:38-42

The contrast is between two types of food, both of which we need in life.

A principal part of christian life is our listening to the word of God like Mary. That's where we find the motivation to find God in the pots and pans and ordinariness, where most of us spend our lives, like Martha.

Someone said – 'my children have left home, now I can serve the Lord!' If she had listened to the word, she would have known that in loving her children she served God!

Listen in peace – Martha was warned about fretting and worry. The quality of her cooking was not in question! The better part is to listen so that we can work in service of others with love. Love grows at the feet of the Lord.

Otherwise our service can be grudging. Why should I do it all? Or self-serving – look how lovely my tea is! Or fussy – 'go on, go on, go on, have another cup'. Prayer teaches us to serve others with love.

Jesus reveals himself everywhere and in everyone. But our ears are attuned by prayer with him. We learn his language and listen. If we spend time at his feet, we will be helped to recognize him everywhere.

So the lady in question – she had served God all her life. She had the prayer part. If we give time to the better part – listening in prayer, then we will find the better part in service too, while knowing our service is valued.
